Describe Synergy	Synergy is when an ability is strengthened greatly by the use of a prior ability that another pet has cast beforehand. For example, a pet uses an ability that creates an electrical storm, which adds extra damage to each attack. This means that when a pet uses an attack that hit multiple times, each attack hits for extra damage. This is important to help defeat a stronger opponent.	Synergy refers to the combination of effects amongst pets in a team (and in the opposing team) that yield greater results than the effects used individually. There are many kinds of synergy, including offensive/defensive, coverage, methodological, diversity, species synergistic, and effectual.	6	5	
Describe Telegraphing	Telegraphing is when you use a move that will do damage in a subsequent turn, however the opponent will be able to see you prepare the move and thus can take steps to reduce or indeed avoid the damage entirely. Therefore it is important to set the condition so that the opponent will be unable to avoid the attack so that the damage can be done, such as when an opponent is recovering.	Telegraphing refers to indicating to your opponent a move you intend to do. This can be a using a pet trick that sets up for an attack (for example, Wind Up followed by another Wind Up) or a multi-turn trick. It should be avoided because your opponent can prepare for the attack (for example, by swapping in a pet that can better defend against it, avoiding the attack with shielding, burrowing, etc.).	6	6
